
LENGA FAMILY TREE



Khaya Lenga

Birth date unknown, probably in Warsaw. Lived in Warsaw. Moved to Israel before WWII. Her children and grandchildren lived in Israel as well.

Khaim Meir Lenga

Birth date unknown, probably in Warsaw.

Lived in Mogelnice, Poland.

Last seen with his wife Faiche and four of his children (Khazkel, Perle, Reuven and Khil) by Khil (Harry) Lenga in the Warsaw Ghetto at a Passover Seder in April 1941. All of them died in WWII on unknown dates. The parents likely died in the Warsaw Ghetto or were murdered in Treblinka. His remaining children, Rachel, Elimelkh and Raizl, moved to Israel before WWII and built families of their own. Their children, grandchildren and great grandchildren live in Israel, the United States and Canada.

Pinkhas Lenga

Birth date August 18, 1891, probably in Warsaw. Lived and worked as a watchmaker in Paris before and during WWII. He and his son Khil were sent to Auschwitz where the died on unknown dates. His wife Rachel and their two daughters, Fanny and Rosette, survived and continued to live in France after WWII. Their grandchildren now live in the United States.

Malka Reyle Wildenberg Lenga

(1st wife of Mikhoel who bore all of his children) Born in Kozhnitz on unknown date. Lived in Kozhnitz and died in childbirth before WWII during winter of 1924.



Mikhoel Lenga

Born July 14, 1888 in Warsaw. Lived and worked as a watchmaker in Kozhnitz, Poland before and during WWII until he was murdered in gas chambers of Treblinka on September 27, 1942. Malka Wilchick Lenga

Birth date unknown.
Lived in Kozhnitz before and during WWII until she was murdered in gas chambers of Treblinka on September 27, 1942.



Izak (Yitzkhak) Lenga

Born April 24, 1913, in Kozhnitz. Escaped German occupied Warsaw before Ghetto established and survived WWII in Russian labor camp in Siberia. Lived and worked as a steel worker in Israel after WWII. Died of natural causes August 3, 1985. His children, grandchildren and great grandchildren live in Israel and Australia.



Mailekh (Marcel) Lenga

Born November 25, 1914, in Kozhnitz. Survived the ghettos and camps of German occupied Poland with his two brothers. Lived and owned a retail clothing store in Paris after WWII. Died of natural causes on September 13, 1975. His daughters, grandchildren and great grandchildren live in France and Israel.



Khana Lenga

Born January 1, 1917, in Kozhnitz. Married a man named Toyvia during WWII and moved to Schidlovitz. She was four months pregnant with her first child when she was murdered in the gas chambers of Treblinka on September 26, 1942.



Khil (Harry) Lenga

Born August 4, 1919, in Kozhnitz. Survived the ghettos and camps of German occupied Poland with his two brothers. Lived and worked as a watchmaker in St. Louis, Missouri after WWII. Died of natural causes in Israel on January 2, 2000. His sons and grandchildren live in the United States and Israel.



Moishe (Morris) Lenga

Born February 19, 1922, in Kozhnitz. Survived the ghettos and camps of German occupied Poland with his two brothers. Lived and worked as a watchmaker in St. Louis, Missouri after WWII. Died of natural causes on February 3, 2008. His daughters, grandchildren and great grandchildren live in the United States.
